Important:

1. This standard form may only be used by consumers whom have applied for debt review.
2. The credit provider can only cancel debit orders relating to the credit agreements between the debt review consumer and the credit provider.
3. If there is more than one consumer who is party to the credit agreement between the debt review consumer and the credit provider, all consumers must sign this form.
4. The consumer may incur a cost / charge with regard to the cancellation of the debit orders.
5. If the debit order has been signed with any party other than FNB (3rd party), then the current account holder (you) must cancel such debit order directly with the 3rd party. Example: if you have authorized DSTV to take money from your account each month by debit order, then you as the account holder must cancel the debit order with DSTV.
6. Stop payments on debit orders can be placed at a branch / online / by telephone banking dependant on your bank.
7. Stop payments have a validity period and therefore more than one stop payment may be required.

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
